

ORANGE is Ollie's mood when the air becomes even *more crude*.

Air Quality Index = 101 - 150



RED Ollie is downright sad when the ozone is *really bad*!


Air Quality Index = 151 - 200

PURPLE means you absolutely cannot go out, and Ollie gives us a *super pout*!

Air Quality Index = 201+




After coloring Ollie above, find and color the matching Ollie face in the stack on the right. Do you remember the color that goes with each face?

How can we help make sure our family car's engine is not sick? Help guide Tex's family car through the maze. It really needs a mechanic!


