## TIPS FOR PEDESTRIAN SAFETY

- At the Intersection, STOP! Look over your shoulder for cars turning. When all is clear, walk straight across the street, not on a diagonal.
- It is the pedestrian's responsibility to yield to cars when crossing a road without crosswalks.
- Before stepping off a curb, look left, look right, look again over your shoulder.
- Dress to be seen. Use brightly colored clothing during the daytime hours and use special reflective material on your clothing at night
- If a car is parked where you are crossing, make sure there is no driver in the car, then go to the edge of the car and look left –right-left until no cars are coming.
- Always walk on a sidewalk
- If there is no sidewalk and you have to walk on the road, always walk FACING traffic so you can see that any car that might lose control.

## TIPS FOR MOTORISTS' SAFETY

- Be Cautious: Do not speed through intersections even if you have the right of way.
- Look out for drivers, pedestrians and bicyclists.
- Turning vehicles must yield to pedestrians crossing on a green light
- Slow down for older pedestrians who need more time to cross the road or children playing near or crossing the street. Be courteous to all pedestrians who share the road with you. Treat pedestrians with respect.
- Stay alert and slow down on residential streets and through school zones.
- Take a second look. Look once for traffic and take a second look for pedestrians.
- Obey all traffic regulations.
