El Paso Clean Air Ordinance Change

What is this notification?

This is a notification to inform you of the changes to the City Ordinance, Title 9.50 (Public and Workplace Smoking Restrictions).

What is the change?

As of September 1, 2014 all smoking, including e-cigarettes, is prohibited in all enclosed areas of public spaces and within 20 feet of the entrance.

The city ordinance defines “E-cigarette” as any electronic oral device or nicotine delivery device, such as one composed of a heating element, battery, and/or electronic circuit which provides a vapor of nicotine or any other substance, which simulates smoking. The term shall include any such device, whether manufactured, distributed, marketed, or sold as an e-cigarette, e-cigar, e-pipe, vape pen, or under any other product name or description.

What is the purpose?

The purpose of Title 9.50 is to improve and protect the public’s health by:

- Eliminating smoking in public places and places of employment
- Guaranteeing the right of non-smokers to breathe smoke-free air
- Recognizing that the need to breathe smoke-free air shall have priority over the choice to smoke
